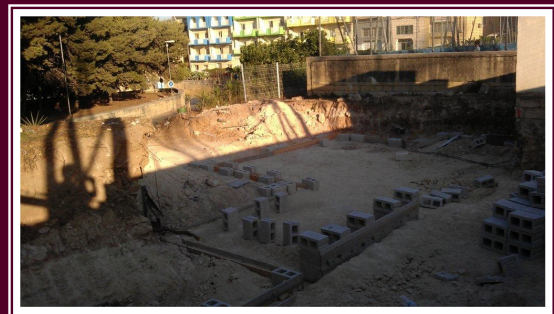

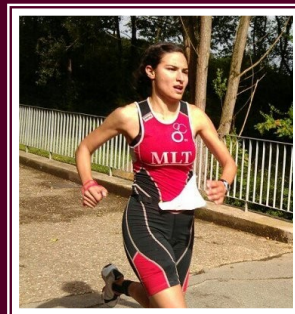
REPRESENTATION AT THE TRIATHLON CHAMPIONSHIPS OF THE SMALL STATES OF EUROPE

On Sunday 8th July, Johanna Calleja, PA to the CEO, represented Malta at the Triathlon Championships of the Small States of Europe. The triathlon covered an Olympic distance of 1.5km swim, 40km cycle and 10km run.

Out of a field of 93 triathletes from several countries including Luxembourg, Portugal, Spain, Belgium, Netherlands, Germany, Poland, France, Austria and Canada, Johanna clocked in eighth woman (and 53rd overall) with a time of 2:28:51.
