SPEAKER

Mr Mark Musù joined the Public Service in 1986, holding various positions within the Ministry for the Family and Social Solidarity and Department of Social Security ever since. He worked in various positions within this Department. In December 2005, he was appointed Director responsible for EU & International Affairs within the Ministry for the Family and Social Solidarity. In November 2008, Mr Musù was appointed Director (Strategic Development and International Relations) in the Department of Social Security and in November 2012, Director (Pensions Strategy). In March 2013 he was appointed Permanent Secretary within the Ministry for the Family and Social Solidarity. In March 2017, he was confirmed as Permanent Secretary in the now renamed Ministry for the Family, Children's Rights and Social Solidarity. He has also been re-appointed as Chairperson of the Pensions Strategy Group which after drawing up the 2015 pension strategy, is now tasked with presenting the 2020 strategic review report aimed at securing the adequacy and sustainability of the pension system in Malta.
