AIM AND CONTENTS OF THE SEMINAR

Over the past few years, accountants and auditors have had to identify, understand and acknowledge the significant accounting changes arising from three new Standards, including the new impairment model in IFRS 9 – Financial Instruments, the five-step model in IFRS 15 – Revenue from Contracts with Customers and the recognition of the lessee’s rights and obligations in terms of IFRS 16 - Leases. This seminar will focus on the practical implications and the major accounting challenges arising from the adoption of these Standards.

SPEAKER

Ms Giselle Cini graduated from the University of Malta with first class honours and joined Deloitte in 1999. She joined the firm’s Technical Department in 2005 and today leads the IFRS division of the Malta firm. In July 2015, she was appointed to the position of Principal within the firm.
