- (c) other challenging issues in company law, including the effects of Covid-19, company closures, developments in the Boeing, Volkswagen and other mishaps

This activity will be of interest to students and practitioners of company law, including company directors and secretaries, accountants and auditors.

### SPEAKER

David Fabri LL.D., Ph.D (Melit) until recently headed the Department of Commercial Law at the University of Malta where he still lectures and co-ordinates the Masters in Financial Services. He has lectured at University since 1995 and his main areas of interest include company law, financial services legislation, consumer protection policy, whistle-blowing and business ethics, subjects on which he has written and lectured extensively. He has served on the University Research Ethics Committee, the Cooperatives Board, the Consumer Affairs Council and is currently a member of the Administrative Review Tribunal. Between 1992 and 2015, he occupied senior positions with the Malta Financial Services Authority.

He was co-drafter of various laws, including the Companies Act, the Malta Financial Services Authority Act and the Co-operative Societies Act. He has been involved in company law issues since 1980.
