- Annual VAT Declarations filed by Article 11 registered persons,
- Forms 04 & 05 filed by Article 12 registered persons,
- Intrastat Arrival and Dispatch Forms, and
- VAT adjustment forms.

Attendees are encouraged to come forward with any questions they might have during the session, which will be discussed and answered during the session itself with a view to ensuring that the subject matter is properly understood and any issues clarified.
