SPEAKER

Mr Mark Musù joined the Public Service in 1986, holding various positions within the Ministry for the Family and Social Solidarity and Department of Social Security ever since. He worked in various positions within this Department. In December 2005, he was appointed Director responsible for EU & International Affairs within the Ministry for the Family and Social Solidarity. In November 2008, Mr Musù was appointed Director (Strategic Development and International Relations) in the Department of Social Security and in November 2012, Director (Pensions Strategy). In March 2013 he was appointed Permanent Secretary within the Ministry for the Family and Social Solidarity. In March 2017, he was confirmed as Permanent Secretary in the Ministry for the Family, Children's Rights and Social Solidarity and has again been re-confirmed for a further term in March 2020 in the now Ministry for Social Justice and Solidarity, the Family and Children's Rights. He is the Chairperson of the Pensions Strategy Group which has recently submitted its 2020 strategic review report aimed at securing the adequacy and sustainability of the pension system in Malta.
